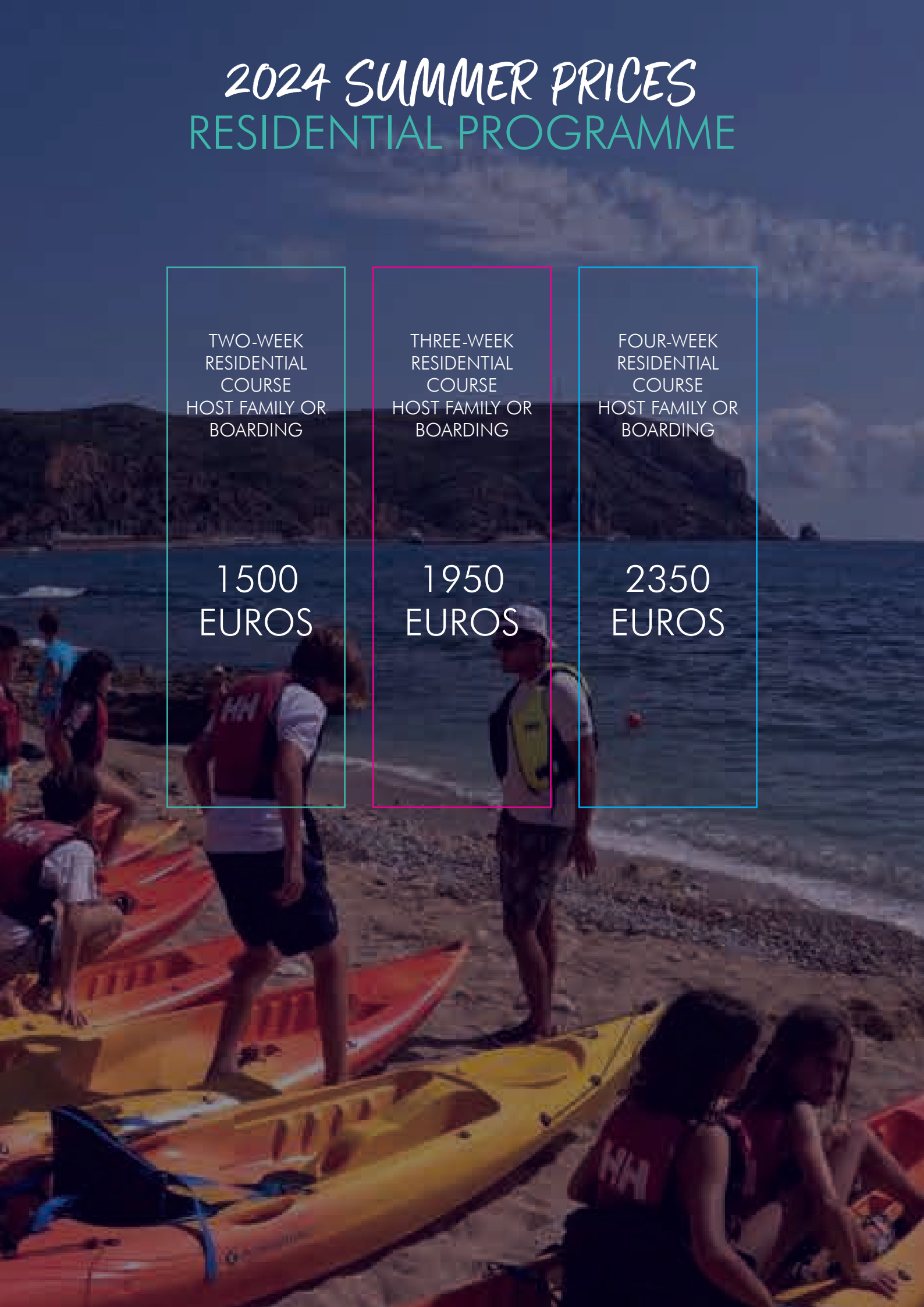

Children will complete fun filled activities and projects based on the book Around the World in Eighty Days which could include the following:

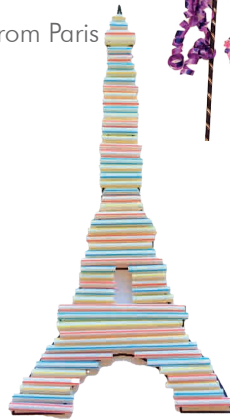
4 YEAR OLDS (FOUNDATION 1 & 2)

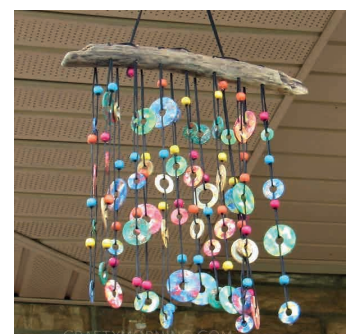

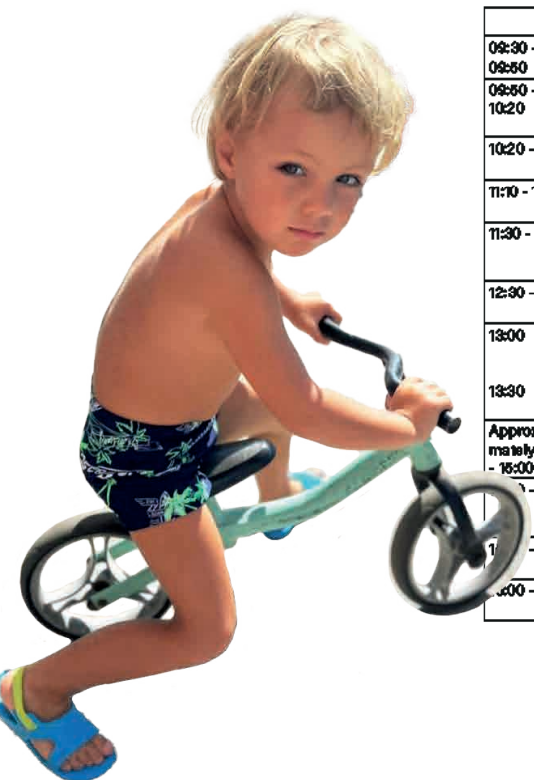

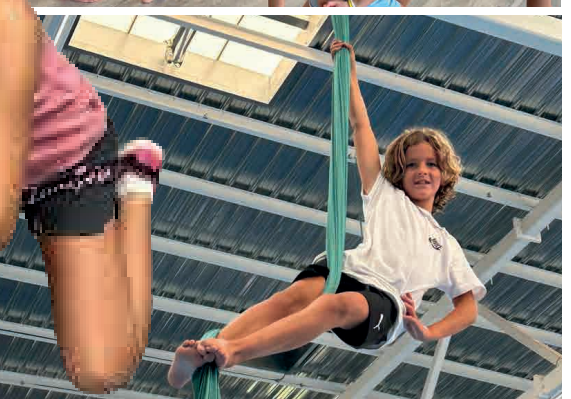

Year 7 and Year 8 pupils follow the same programme as older students, however, they are separated into age groups in both English or Spanish classes, and activity classes, to ensure that they are with children the same age. They are assessed at the start of the course and placed in English or Spanish classes according to their level. As well as the academic subjects, students will also enjoy a variety of different activities including, sport, cooking, swimming, art, performing arts, circus skills, karate, tennis, padel, woodwork and team building activities. During the week they will attend an outdoor activity such as stand up paddle, snorkelling and kayaking, a ropes course in Parcent or visit Aqua Natura, one of the local water parks in Benidorm.

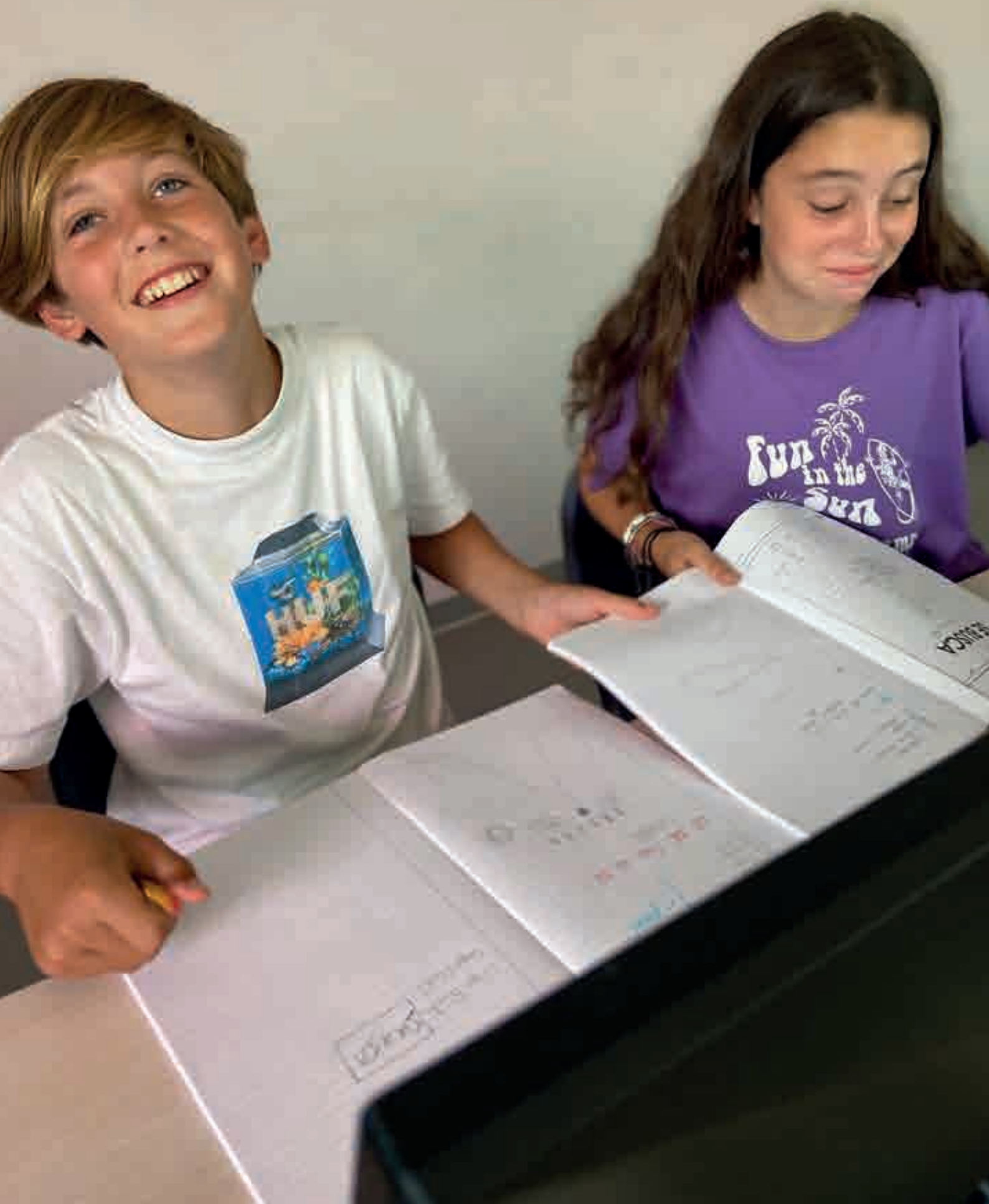
13 - 17 YEARS

2024 SUMMER SPANISH PROGRAMME

YEAR 9 - YEAR 13

13 - 17 YEARS

Spanish language sessions are conducted in a full Spanish immersion environment and designed to promote proficient use of grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, speaking, listening, reading, writing and conversational Spanish. Classes are structured around either A Level or GCSE exam preparation and are taught by teachers who specialise in preparing students for these exams.

Formal Spanish classes are offered at three different levels; pre-intermediate, intermediate and advanced. Students work in small groups to build confidence and fluency in real life scenarios. They'll develop skills in thinking, reading, writing, listening and speaking in Spanish. Students will get feedback from their teachers who will inform them of the areas they need to do more work on.

As well as Spanish lessons, students will also enjoy a variety of different activities including, sport, cooking, swimming, art, performing arts, circus skills, karate, tennis, padel, woodwork and photography. During the week they will attend an outdoor activity such as Stand Up Paddle, Snorkelling and Kayaking, Bike-Riding or a Ropes Course in Parcent.

Our classes cover:

2024 SUMMER PROGRAMME ACTIVITIES



The activities at Lady Elizabeth School are the counterpart to academic classes. While still structured and disciplined, they give students a chance to enjoy sporting and creative activities to further develop their knowledge and skills. Teachers of the individual activities are subject specialists with a lot of experience. Students are accompanied, to each activity, by a monitor who stays with them for all lessons.

School based activities vary for each age group. Activities include, sport and swimming, art, photography and design, circus skills, performing arts including acting, dance and stunts, cooking, woodwork, karate and boxing. For the teenagers, the last lesson of the day is where students get to choose from a variety of workshops such as yoga, film making, tennis, padel and public speaking.

IN SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

COOKING (all ages)

Cooking is an all-time favourite at Summer Camp. Students enjoy experimenting in the kitchen and making a variety of different dishes in their cooking lessons. Younger pupils learn to ice cakes, make pizzas, make and ice biscuits and so much more. The older students participate in a Master Chef style competition, at the end of the second week of the programme. The competition gives students the chance to put their cooking skills to the test. They have to prepare a three course meal under timed conditions. Presentation, efficiency and the final result will be judged by a panel of Summer School Staff.

Cooking is a lot of fun and a great opportunity for students to improve their English or Spanish and their cooking skills.



SPORT (all ages)

Pupils try new sports or improve on skills they may be already developing. Football, volleyball, spike ball, rounders, rugby, cricket, swimming, frisbee, softball, hockey and many other sports are played throughout the weeks at Summer Camp. Younger children enjoy mini Olympics, swimming competitions, tennis and many other fun sporting activities. For the teenage students, there are regular competitions and team events for everyone to participate in. Duathlon, triathlons, sports challenges and survival style races are all a great way to promote team spirit. Rollerblading has become a very popular sporting activity at camp.

Outdoor education is part of Summer Camp with older students able to participate in activities such as mountain bike riding, orienteering, kayaking, stand up paddle and regular visits are made to local padel and tennis courts.



IN SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

CIRCUS SKILLS *(all ages)*

Stilt walking, aerial acrobatics, juggling, uni-cycle riding, balance and diabolo are some of the skills taught during circus lessons. Students enjoy the challenge of learning new things and trying the more difficult activities under the watchful eye of our professional circus teacher.



PERFORMING ARTS *(all ages)*

The Performing Arts course gives students a new and interactive way to hone their English or Spanish skills and become stars of the stage! Classes include dance, drama, martial arts, gymnastics and stunts. Classes are adapted according to age.

IN SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

ART, PHOTOGRAPHY & DESIGN

(Art - all ages, Photography & Design 13 - 16)

Students who like art and enjoy being creative will love spending Art and Design lessons working on some great artistic projects based around the fortnightly themes. Older students will also have the opportunity to complete some photography based projects and learning to edit them using Photoshop and other editing programs.



WOODWORK (4 - 17 years)

We have included woodwork in the programme to give students the opportunity to learn new skills and to complete a small woodwork project to take home. They will learn how to use basic woodwork tools under the supervision of an experienced carpenter and woodwork teacher.

Over the two week period they will manage their own project and enjoy seeing the final outcome. Students love to create and there is nothing more satisfying than working on a project from start to finish.



IN SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

KARATE (all ages)

Karate is a great form of exercise and discipline for students. In classes, students will look at self-defence, technique and some basic skills in karate. The classes are held by a

black-belt instructor who is energetic and passionate about karate.



WORKSHOPS/CHOICE OF ACTIVITIES (13 - 17 years)

For the last lesson of the day, students will be given the choice of different workshops and activities including film making, public speaking, yoga, karate, tennis, football, bike riding, swimming and circus skills. They will make their choices at the beginning of the week for the whole week. A broad range of activities are available for students to choose from.



OUT OF SCHOOL EXCURSIONS KAYAKING, STAND UP PADDLE and SNORKELLING (9 - 17 years)

What better place to spend time on the sea than the sparkling Mediterranean. Kayaking, stand up paddle and snorkelling are enjoyed by students when they take a day out of school and travel the short distance to one of the beautiful local beaches. Monitors give students instruction so that students learn the correct technique, but they also get free time just to play around and have fun with their friends.

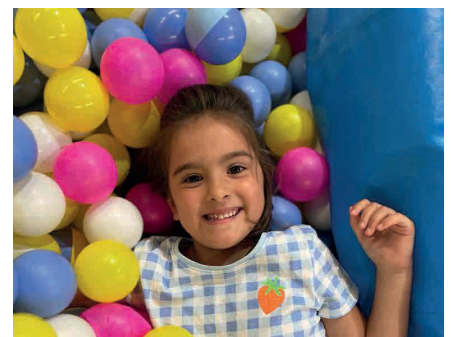




OUT OF SCHOOL EXCURSIONS

RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMME @SUMMER SCHOOL

In 2024 we have two residential options. Students can either stay with a Host Family or they can stay in the Boarding Facility which is approximately 30 minutes from Lady Elizabeth School. Either way, students will have a wonderful time getting to know other students from different countries around the world whilst studying English or Spanish in a fabulous safe environment.

HOST FAMILY RESIDENTIAL

We hand-pick our Host Families, visiting their homes and ensuring that they have up-to-date police checks and that they complete a safe-guarding course. We try and make the best possible matches between students and families to ensure that they all have a great summer experience.

Many of our Host Families have children of their own whilst others have grown-up children who live away from home. Either way the Host Parents are welcoming and children staying with them are made to feel welcome and comfortable.

During the week students have breakfast with the Host Family before they leave for school. Some Host Families drive the children to The Lady Elizabeth School and others use the bus service. Families provide the students with a snack and a drink for break time and lunch is provided by the school.

The evening meal is had with the Host Family and on many occasions Host Families get together with other families to have BBQs or social gatherings where students can see their friends from school.

We offer 24-hour assistance and pastoral care for our families and the students staying with them.

We know and trust our families and the best testimonials that we have are that students want to repeat with the same family year after year.



RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMME @SUMMER SCHOOL

BOARDING HOUSE FACILITY

A fabulous addition to Summer School is our wonderful Boarding House Facility which is situated within 30 minutes of Lady Elizabeth School.

House Parents care for a small number of children aged from 12 to 17 years from different countries around the world. A bus transports students to and from school each morning and in the afternoon and in the evenings there are activities organised by the House Parents, either on the beach in Javea, or in the Boarding House.

The Boarding Facility has a large pool, a table tennis table, large community areas and is beautifully furnished. Meals are prepared by the House Parents and all students will eat together in the dining area.

On Saturday boarders go with other students, staying with Host Families, to one of the theme parks in Benidorm. Sunday is a day for cultural trips to Valencia or Alicante, or the to visit the beach to participate in one of the great outdoor activities in the local area.

Students will have an unforgettable experience staying in the Boarding House and will make lasting friendships with students from all around the world.



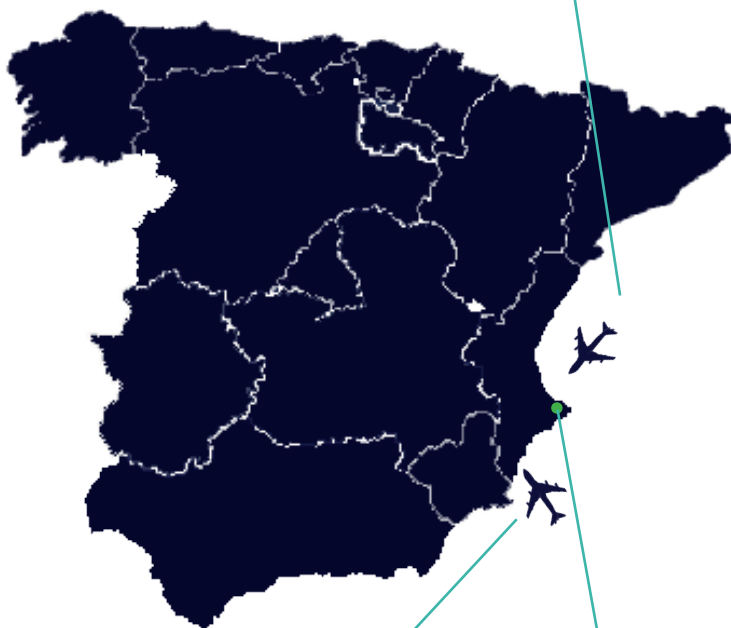
